Currently, he serves as Director of the Environmental Disasters Department at the United Arab Emirates Ministry of Climate Change and Environment, his main role is to assure the prevention and mitigation to all environmental disasters occurring in the UAE specifically marine pollutions, animal and agricultural diseases.
